POTTY TRAINING SCHEDULE

Some people will need to change and adapt to suit the dog's habits. For example, some dogs will relieve themselves immediately after eating and drinking; others will wait half an hour or longer.

Once you learn how long your dog needs, you can adjust this schedule accordingly. Just be consistent and make sure everyone in the family is doing the same schedule.

The puppy should only be out of the crate when you are able to watch him/her closely.

As he/she matures and becomes more trustworthy, you can give him longer periods of freedom until he/she only needs to be confined to a crate when you go out.

ALWAYS TAKE YOUR PUPPY OUTSIDE:

- As soon as he wakes up in the morning.
- After every meal and drink of water.
- After he awakens from a nap
- 👺 Before any extra freedom period
- After unusual excitement and/or long play periods
- The last thing at night.

You may be taking your puppy out up to 10+ times a day during the first week, but once you have a routine you should be able to decrease this to 5-6 times a day.
